ENGLAND	19 July		<b>NO RESTRICTIONS</b> - Mask wearing optional Pet and veterinary services, charity shops and all pet businesses operating as pre-lockdown. IRELAND	19 July	26 July	All travel allowed within Republic of Ireland; Non-essential foreign travel still not advised but permitted post-19 July in EU with a digital Covid passport; Office workers asked to continue to work from home; Hospitality indoors due to open on 26 July with proof of vaccination; Rehoming centres closed to the public but can operate appointment system for members of the public travelling to the Centre; Donations of bedding and food now accepted; Volunteers may be used but not advised if subject to the same restrictions as office workers; Face masks and social distancing still in place in all areas of work and society.	
NORTHERN IRELAND	24 May	26 July	Pet and veterinary services essential businesses; Charity frontline workers key workers; Centres open, remote rehoming by appointment; Charity shops open; Pet shops and dog groomers open; Indoor gatherings up to 15 persons; Outdoor gatherings up to 30 persons without risk assessment.
